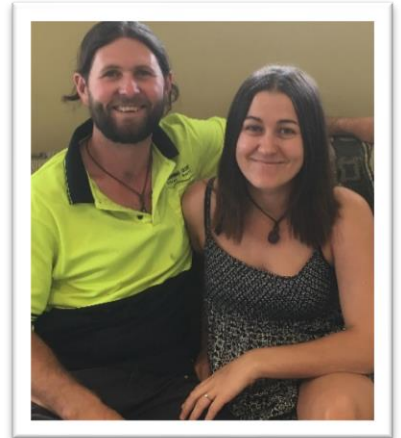


What's News @ The Glory

Elders and their families came from far & wide across Australia to Reconnect with their land and their “mob”. Morning Glory hosted some of those families – many of whom have a very deep connection with the local area.

Deborah Cheetham AO – Indigenous Soprano/Short Black Opera Company/Dhungala Childrens Choir,

Coloured Stone – a well known Indigenous band originating from Ceduna, South Australia.

Worms & Wood

Just a reminder that we sell 3-day fishing licenses at the kiosk (\$7) and also stock bait.

Scrub worms, bardi grubs, corn kernels and tasty cheese seem to be the menu of choice for the fish – all of which we sell at the kiosk!

We sell bags of Red Gum (\$15) and also by half metre crate (\$80) & full metre crate(\$150) for use in camp fire drums.

Please be aware of Fire Danger Warnings – these will be posted at the kiosk/reception .

Current River Level

After having a dry winter and spring we finally got some much needed rain in December.

The river is now at its usual Summer level of 2.7 metres due to early summer rains.

The rain came just after cropping was completed and
